We believe our residency program and care team should reflect the diversity of the community we serve. The **Lancaster General Hospital Family Medicine Residency Underrepresented Minority Student Elective** is a four-week rotation designed specifically for underrepresented minority 4th year students who plan to specialize in family medicine. Participants will be introduced to the broad range of experiences and opportunities available within our residency program and surrounding communities, under the guidance and mentorship of a diverse group of family medicine residents, faculty members, and community physicians. Students should be enrolled in U.S., LCME-accredited or osteopathic institutions.

This rotation will include hands-on experiences in:

- Inpatient Obstetrics & Medicine
- Outpatient Family Medicine in Urban & Rural Locations
- Individual Mentorship by Select Residents & Faculty
- A range of selective opportunities including integrative and adolescent medicine, hospice care, geriatrics, sports medicine, and much more



Rotation Details:

Each four-week rotation will be arranged according to student schedules and program space availability. Weekly schedules will be provided at the start of the rotation. Housing, Wi-Fi, meal card, and parking are provided for the duration of the rotation. While housing is within walking distance of the main hospital, a personal vehicle will be necessary for ambulatory experiences.
